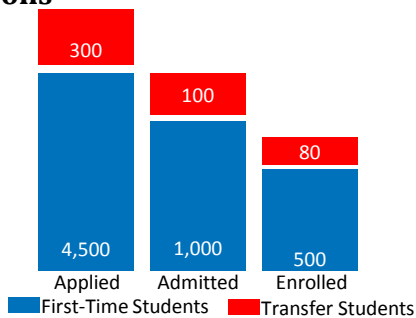
About Wicksell

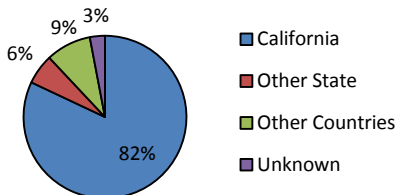

Freshman Class Geographical Profile

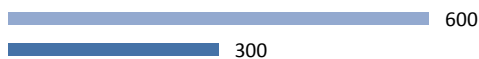

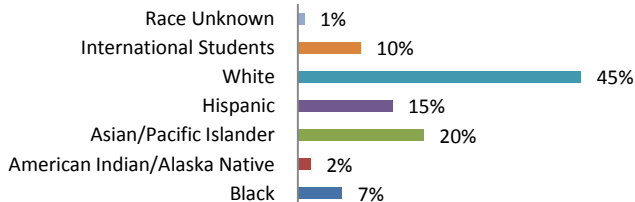

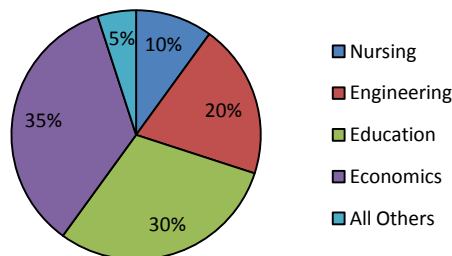

Number of Degrees Awarded Last Year

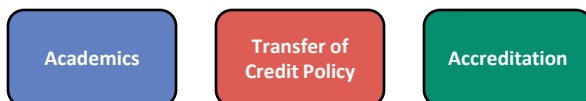


Bachelor's Degrees Awarded Last Year *



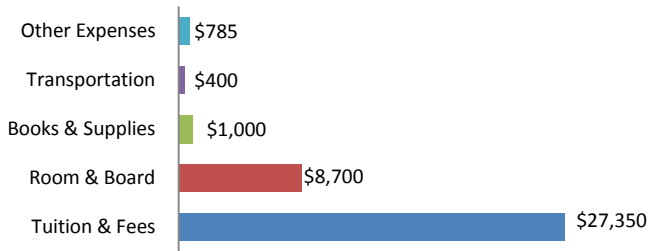

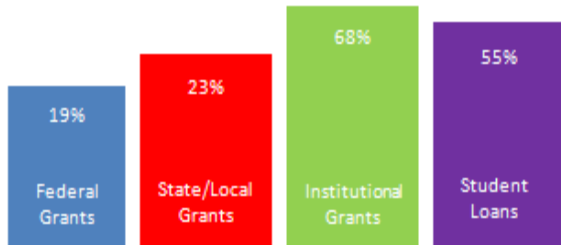


What Students Pay

Percent of Freshmen Receiving Aid by Type



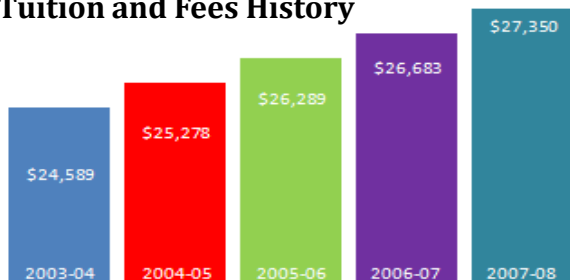

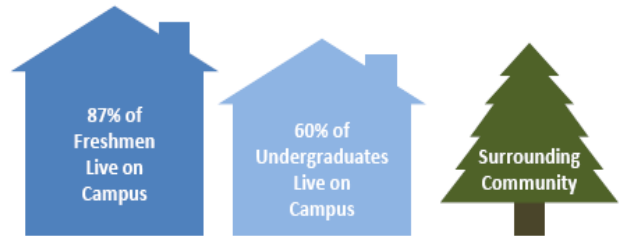

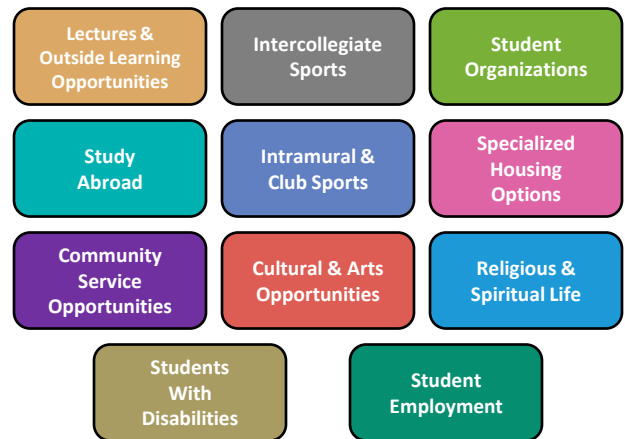
About Campus Life
