

NAICU'S ACCESS & SUCCESS PROGRAM SURVEY

There is an extraordinary array of efforts already underway in American higher education that could serve as a testing ground for the President's vision to become first in the world in college completion by 2020. These efforts show the potential positive impact a Presidential initiative to increase college success could have. The personal stories of hard work and achievement behind these programs build on the American spirit and appeal to citizens across the political spectrum.

Of the more than 240 programs submitted by 136 institutions, following are examples of programs initiated at our *Access, Persistence and Cost: Fresh Perspectives* (Tuesday, February 2nd, 10-11:00am) panelist member institutions that are both innovative and having a positive impact on access and/or completion rates:

- ***Mount St. Mary's College (CA) – First-Generation Student Success Program.***

This program revolves around a faculty learning community composed of faculty who teach introductory courses critical to first-generation student success. The faculty partner with students to develop and present course-related seminars, craft classroom-based co-curricular programs that deepen and extend course content, and collaborate with student family members to improve classroom success. Application of faculty strategies through monthly seminars require students to develop and present materials in front of peers to reinforce basic academic skills. The seminars extend educational content beyond the classroom, and facilitate the personal connection between students and faculty and educational programming.

- ***Knox College (IL) – Recruiting and Enlightening through Access to and Communication with High-need Schools (REACH) Fellows Program.***

REACH targets under-represented groups (first-generation, low-income, minority and male students) pursuing careers in K-12 teaching with intensive instructional and practical experiences to prepare them for work in high-need schools. Of the 29 students who have participate in the program since it began in 2007, 18 are still at Knox and 11 have graduated. Ten of the graduates are now teaching in high-needs schools, and one is in the Peace Corps.

- ***St. Edward's University (TX) – College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP).***

CAMP is designed to provide academic, financial and moral support for eligible migrant students, assisting migrant and seasonal farm-workers and their immediate family members to successfully complete the first undergraduate year of study, and providing follow-up services to help students continue in postsecondary education. The admission office recruits 35 eligible students in each freshmen class, roughly 5 percent of the total freshmen enrollment. Eighty-nine percent of fall 2008 cohort returned for fall 2009; the average first-year retention rate for CAMP students (fall 2004 through fall 2008) is 84.3%.
